



Membership Types

Types of Memberships available in FFAO for the Year 2009-2010

Note: Annual Dues run from August 1st through to July 31st.

Dues are payable at the start of the fiscal year.

Department Membership - Any Fire Department, Fire Company, Fire Fighters' Association, has completed an application and pays annual Dues.

Delegates - An active firefighter or a member of ladies auxiliary, duly elected by the membership of their home Fire Department, Fire Company, Ladies Auxiliary or Fire Fighters' Association, at any meeting of that Association. Delegates shall have voting privileges. No Dues.

Note: Delegates are expected to respond to their roll call at the Annual meeting as well as march in the Memorial Parade and respond to their roll call after the service.

Life Member – A person who is 21 or over and is an individual firefighter or member of the Ladies Auxiliary or Firefighters Assoc in good standing as a Delegate, who has attended and registered three fiscal years as a Delegate and attended 50% of the Quarterly meetings plus annual meeting. A visitor or Individual Member who is 23 or over and attended a minimum of 50% of the quarterly meetings and annual meetings per year and must include 5 Annual meetings. Dues are \$20.00 per year.

A Medal of Merit recipient shall receive a Life Membership in this Association as long as they pay annual dues. They have voting privileges.

Visitor – A person, 18 years of age or older, who has an interest in the FFAO. Shall sign in as a visitor to each quarterly and annual meetings attended. No voting privileges. No dues. A Visitor can work towards a Life Membership. *See Life Member for criteria to become a life member.

Individual Member - A person, 18 years of age or older, who has an interest in the FFAO and has completed an application and pays annual dues. Dues are \$25.00 per year. No voting privileges. An Individual member can work towards Life Membership . * See Life Membership for criterea.

Honorary Member - Any person who has rendered a valued service to this Association in the opinion of the Executive Committee. Shall not have voting privileges, cannot hold office and shall be exempt from dues.

Associate Member - Any organization, manufacturer or supplier, with interest in the fire service. Such membership is not entitled the seating of Delegates or voting privileges. Dues are determined by the Executive Committee.

Dues are:

- \$200.00 per year for membership.
- \$200.00 for web advertising.
- or \$300.00 for membership & web.
