District Fire Chief, Wayne Nie of the Haldimand County Fire Service, Station # 10 in Byng (Formerly Dunnville Fire Station # 2) has retired from the Department following a distinguished 32 years of service to this community. Retired Chief Nie, joined the Fire Department on November 30, 1978. In November of 1980 he was promoted to the position of Captain and remained there until June of 1993, when he was promoted to the District Fire Chief's position which he has held through until December 31, 2009.
